

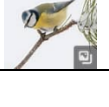
Chadwell Millennium Green

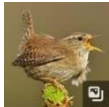
2025 Bird Survey (January to March)

The below table documents the number of birds seen or heard in the Millennium Green during the dates shown. To avoid confusion in relation to counting the same birds on different occasions, the highest count on any given day will be recorded in the total column.

A total of six visits were made in this period (January, February and March) with all habitats checked in fine conditions. No distinction has been made between species and the habitats they were recorded in, but future surveys can be tailored to address this, with site maps added.

The survey revealed a total of 23 species of birds using or visiting the Millennium Green. This is the first survey undertaken in the Green and it is encouraging that there is a wide variety of birds in and around the Green.
